ETA (NSW) invites English teachers and educators to submit outlines for workshops, presentations and poster sessions to be presented at our 2009 Annual Conference. Successfully negotiating the computer roll-out and wider curriculum changes will require more than a quick cut-and-paste in programming and practice. We will need to consider how to use our knowledge and classroom practices in different ways, without compromising what was good in the past or limiting the possibilities of the future. The Annual Conference will provide opportunities for delegates to re-invigorate existing practices and embrace innovations.

Presenters have a choice of 2 types of sessions:

- Presentations: 1 ¼ hours**
The presentation should be approximately an hour in length and allow for a 15-minute Question and Answer session for participants.
- Workshops: 1 ¼ hours**
These are active sessions involving participants in activities such as problem-solving, developing a teaching technique or exploring practical issues.

Workshops with a hands-on approach will be restricted in number to allow for all delegates to participate fully in a safe and comfortable environment

Printing: ETA is able to complete printing requests for the conference (up to a maximum of 2 pages back to back). Any further material for participants can be made available on the conference web site.

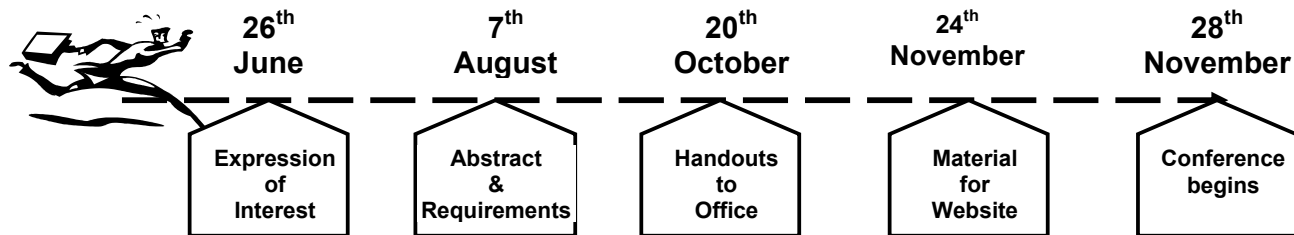
If you wish to print through the ETA, please ensure that
